Fr. Jim Crisman

Fr. Jim Crisman, pastor at St. Francis of Assisi, spoke at our Aug 5 meeting at St. Francis of Assisi.

Fr. Jim was the Vocations Director for the Archdiocese of Denver. He was a teacher before he started seminary. He expected his brother to become a priest, and that he himself would find a wife. But the Lord said "it's not him" (his brother got married). When he answered the call, he experienced peace and joy.

Fr. Jim spoke about "supernatural vocations." A vocation is a relationship with the Lord, the Church, and the world. You have to give up the natural vocation to enter into the supernatural vocation. Super means beyond, as in beyond the normal; it does not mean better. Supernatural vocations are not natural.

The natural vocation is marriage. We are all built for marriage. Spouses in a marriage are helping each other get to heaven.

The supernatural vocations are holy orders (Deacons, Priests, Bishops) and consecrated life (sisters, brothers, nuns, monks, consecrated virgins, consecrated widows).

Fr. Jim encourages single people to consider the consecrated life.

Those who are professed Third Order are living a supernatural vocation if they are living in holy orders or in consecrated vocations.

A transitional deacon is a deacon who is headed for the priesthood. A permanent deacon may be married or unmarried. Once an unmarried deacon is ordained, he may not get married.

Fr. Jim encourages Serrans to pray for supernatural vocations, that all those who are being called to holy orders be open to heeding the call.

Dcn. Mike Berens

Dcn. Mike Berens, deacon at St. John the Baptist, spoke at our Aug 18 meeting.

Dcn. Mike took St. John the Baptist as his confirmation name because he thought it was cool that St. John was beheaded. He says this was most providential as he is now serving at a parish with the same name.

Deacons are in Persona Christi in the life of Christ as a servant. Priests and Bishops were ordained as provisional deacons, so are also deacons. Once a man has been ordained a deacon, he is always a deacon.

Deacons are

- Minister of the Word they preach the good news of Jesus Christ
- Ministers at the Altar they serve at mass and proclaim the Gospel
- Ministers of Charity they bring love and knowledge of Jesus Christ to the world

He did not really hear a call to become a deacon, but for several years he thought about it. He was in Knights of Columbus, serving in Religious Education, and was on a parish council. One year he asked is wife "what do you think" and she just about fell out of her chair. After two years of formation he became discouraged but his wife encouraged him to persevere.

Dcn. Mike asks for our prayers. He says we can shorten his time in purgatory. Deacons need our support. "It's getting tough our there."
