Mike Downey

Our speaker on June 1 at St. Francis of Assisi was Mike Downey, immediate past president of Serra US. He marked his first day post-presidency with us, his term having expired May 31. He was visiting Estes Park on vacation.

He joined Serra 19 years ago. He began his speech by noting that most Serrans are not aware of what is going on at the national level. Two years ago Serra US established 5 priorities:

- Strengthen culture of vocations among Spanish speaking Catholics. Result: established <u>cultural</u> <u>outreach committee</u>, started the <u>Serra</u> <u>Ambassador Program</u>, and began translating Serra materials into Spanish
- Broaden use of Serra vocations programs in parishes. Result: started the <u>Parish Vocation</u> <u>Ignite Workshop program</u> (also <u>here</u>).
- 3. Engage Bishops and Vocations Directors in annual club planning. Result: many clubs now send an annual letter to their Bishop and/or Vocations Director outlining their accomplishments for the past year and describing their agenda for the coming year
- 4. Encourage clubs to recruit younger members (45-55 age range). Result: Serrans are building awareness with FOCUS alumni, booth at FOCUS SEEK convention, booth at Young Catholic Professionals convention
- Charter or restart 5 new clubs. Result: 8 new clubs

Serra US has a booth at the National Eucharistic Congress, where Serra Day will be July 19.

Serra US replaced its membership portal with Club Express, and updated its website <u>SerraSpark.org</u> and its <u>Serran magazine</u> and its <u>holiness</u> <u>handbook</u>, and has continued its <u>Serra Meets</u> monthly webinars.

Many clubs were behind with their IRS filings and that has now been corrected, through the support of one knowledgable and dedicated volunteer.

Remaining challenges:

- 1. improve attendance at club officer training sessions
- 2. improve Regional and District communication and collaboration
- 3. promote awareness of non-US Serra clubs

Fr. Peter Srsich

Our speaker June 14 was <u>Fr. Peter Srsich</u>, parochial vicar at St. Thomas Aquinas in Boulder. Fr. Peter entered seminary at St. John Vianney and was ordained in 2021.

He grew up in Golden. His father had been a fallen away Catholic, and his mother a fallen away Methodist. He remembers his first communion at Christ the King in Evergreen when he was 7 or 8.

While at Mullen High School he started thinking about the priesthood, and went on some retreats during his sophomore and junior years. The summer before his high school senior year, he was diagnosed with stage 4 non-Hodgkins lymphoma. It was painful. He thought about Jesus saying "pick up your cross and follow me." The cancer experience deepened his relationship with Jesus.

He spent two years at Regis, then entered seminary taking it week by week. At the end of his first year, he went on a 30 day silent retreat, asking Jesus "Do you want me to be a priest?" and Jesus said YES. He finished his seminary formation in Rome. Following his ordination he completed the Licentiate in Biblical Theology in Rome at the Pontifical University of the Holy Cross, which means he is qualified to teach at a seminary.

Fr. Peter started serving at St. Thomas Aquinas in July 2023. He said "St. Thom's is a beautiful place with an incredible mission." He remembers expecting a quiet summer, but then immediately on day 1, a Baptist student walks in to <u>Drogo's</u> and asked him "Father, do you have a minute?" This student was in RCIA by the end of the week. "God moves quickly at CU." He is constantly asked "Father, do you have a minute?"

Fr. Peter says the University offers CU students the world, and the students are recognizing that it is not enough. They are consistently told they can do whatever they want, but what they hear is that what you do does not matter. St. Thomas tells them that what they do DOES MATTER! "You matter, and what you do matters."

Fr. Peter says the urgency of the Holy Spirit is amazing. At present at least 5 men are discerning their vocations to the priesthood, and many women are discerning the religious life. Fr. Peter asks us to pray for these men and women to have an open heart.

Our Affirmation Dinner was on Tuesday June 25 at <u>Pinocchios</u> Incredible Italian restaurant in Longmont. Appetizers were followed by a delicious dinner featuring chicken parmesana and tiramisu for dessert.

We enjoyed the attendance of twelve priests and deacons.
