#### Fr. Karl Millis

Fr. Karl Millis was our speaker at St. Francis of Assisi on Saturday morning Oct. 5. Fr. Karl celebrated the 25th anniversary of his ordination in June.

He grew up in Wyoming, attending Holy Rosary in Lander Wyoming. He served in the Diocese of Cheyenne in Wyoming for 15 years, and then in the Diocese of Lincoln in Nebraska for 8 years.

Most recently he trained in deliverance ministry for two years with the <u>Doloran Fathers</u>, and now he is the <u>Parochial Vicar at St. Francis of Assisi</u> in the Archdiocese of Denver.

He told us why St. Junipero Serra is a great saint, a man ahead of his time, a great advocate of the rights of the native people. The missions were not prisons, rather they were protection from the Spanish military and a place for the baptized to live in common away from their pagan native community. The missions were also a place for training in agriculture and trades. There was always a great tension between the civil/military pressures and missionary efforts.

St. Junipero Serra was a tireless missionary with a strong devotion to the blessed Virgin Mary. He was a witness of holiness and a founding father of the United States, and a model of heroic sanctity.

### Fr. Francis Mayinja

Fr. Francis Mayinja spoke to us about his parish in Uganda, Our Lady of Assumption, in Bulo. Fr. Francis was ordained in 1981.

Uganda overall has a population that is 38% Catholic, 28% Anglican, and between 15%-20% Muslim, and the rest are protestants or traditional. His parish is in a muslim area. His diocese is one of 12 in Uganda. The parishes are about 10 miles apart.

The people are poor with low education. Many families walk 1 or 2 miles to get water. Many students have no shoes or uniform. Many schools have no roof. There are no paved roads and the roads are extremely muddy in the rainy season.

The community is agricultural, growing coffee, bananas, yams, sweet potatoes and other vegetables. Some also have livestock: chickens, cattle, goats, and some pigs which of course the muslims don't like.

St. John the Baptist helped build a parish school and funded dormitories and uniforms. It now has 600 students. The diocese overall has 2,000 to 3,000 students. The school children help to reinforce Catholicism in their families.

The surrounding community is curious. The choir is half muslim. Even muslim children come to school mass. Eventually, they might convert. Muslims trust the sisters teaching in the parish schools because their habits include head coverings.

The District 6 Convention was held on October 26th. at St. Francis of Assisi in Castle Rock. The theme was Renewal and Revival.

Congratulations to awardees Kathy K Best VP for Membership, Fr. Mark Best Chaplain, Amy M Best Newsletter, and Jan L Best VP Programs!

Fr. Mark Zacker, Pastor of St. Francis of Assisi in Castle Rock spoke about how the Eucharist is a source of spiritual revival. "Share how Jesus has made a difference in your life." He quoted Dcn. Jim Bachta: [a priest is] a living monstrance who "processes" out into the community making Jesus present to everyone [he encounters].

The Keynote speaker <u>Candice Tyrrell</u> is the VP Membership, Serra US Council.
