### Shroud of Turin

Experimental Physicist Rudolph Dichtl spoke to us at our November 1 meeting about his experience examining the Shroud of Turin in October 1978.

As a child at St. Alphonsus, Rudy learned about the shroud because his parish had a devotion to the shroud. Because he already knew a lot about the shroud and was a Staff Scientist he was asked to be part of the team participating directly in examining it. Rudy worked with Dr. John Jackson and Dr. Eric Jumper on the Shroud of Turin Research Project STURP.

The <u>VP-8 Image Analyzer</u> was used to perform the first ever in-depth scientific examination of the Shroud of Turin. Unlike a photograph produced from the reflection of light, the shroud image contains spatial data: the image density on the cloth is directly proportionate to the distance it was from the body it covered. In essence, the closer the cloth was to the body, the darker the image. To this day, how the image on the shroud was created remains a mystery.

The shroud shows nail wounds on the wrists and a pierce from a blade on the right side of the body.

Rudy brought with him all sorts of artifacts from his long association with the shroud, including a stunning lenticular image of the face of Jesus inspired by the shroud, with one angle showing the face on the shroud, and another angle showing Ariel Agemian's painting, considered by many to be the most accurate.

Rudy says there is much published about the shroud, ever more every year. Some is not credible. See the websites above for good information.

Jake Smith has been conditionally accepted to enter the Denver SJV seminary in the fall of 2025 but has some college loan debt he must pay off before he starts.

He was on the path to become a medical doctor when he received his call to the priesthood. He has a B.S. in Biology from <u>Creighton</u> (a Jesuit University in Omaha Nebraska), an MS in Human Anatomy from <u>CU Anschutz</u>, and an MS in Clinical Sciences. Here's his story:
