Deacon Owen Limarta

Our speaker on March 2 at Sacred Heart of Mary was Deacon Owen Limarta. Dcn. Owen is a transitional deacon ordained in 2023: <u>https://</u> <u>denvercatholic.org/meet-the-archdiocese-of-</u> <u>denvers-newest-transitional-deacons-ordained-</u> <u>feb-18/</u>

He is a seminarian in his last year of formation. He assists St. Francis of Assisi with weekend liturgies and OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation for Adults). He will be ordained to the priesthood on May 11. He will celebrate his first mass at St. Francis of Assisi on May 12 at 5PM.

He is from Indonesia (Batam). When he was in third grade his family converted from Chinese Buddhism. He received a rosary as a baptism gift, and he prayed the rosary before bed every night. He remembers in third grade telling everyone he would be a priest.

His parents wanted him to become a doctor, but because he did not like science, they encouraged him to go to business school. They contacted an education agent, who suggested Oregon State, Colorado State, and the University of South Florida (Tampa). His dad said CSU had a good business school, so he went to CSU to earn a business degree. There, he joined a strong Catholic community at the Newman center with Fr. Rocco Porter.

He says he always had a call to the priesthood. He considered religious orders. He considered the Capuchins and the Dominicans before Fr. Rocco encouraged him to consider being a diocesan priest.

At seminary, many times he felt like giving up, doubting his calling. He sought help from Msgr. Leone, who told him "you will be such a great priest" encouraging him to stick with it.

For Dcn. Owen, the academic studies were less challenging than the formation. During formation, seminarians are watched all the time and constantly being corrected. People can complain about tiny differences. Dcn. Owen asks for our prayers. Priests and seminarians are under constant spiritual attack. We have to work together. He also encourages us to be an example of perseverance through suffering, for many young people who don't have any examples.

At our meeting on March 22, Sister Christine Matheus MSC, a Missionary Sister of the Most Sacred Heart, came as a guest. She helped us assemble treat bags for our youth altar servers.

Inspired by Mother Cabrini, she is starting a school in Namibia.
